

## Soccer Tryout Information 2023-2024

Tryouts will still begin on **Monday, March 4th at 7:00 a.m. sharp** (participants should be arriving no later than 6:45 a.m.). If your child is participating in the UIL Choir event that morning, they need to let me know either in person or via email this week so that it does not count against them.

After the second day of tryouts on Thursday, March 7th, we will post a round of cuts on the girls soccer webpage found on the McCullough Athletics site:

There will be a third day of tryouts on Friday, March 8th (also 4:30PM-6PM after school.) for those who make it to the next round. From there, we will post who made the team that evening along with information about the season, which starts immediately when we return from the break.

If your child is unable to attend either of the first two days of tryouts (March 4th and 7th) for any reason other than a school-sponsored UIL event, they will not be invited back to try out on Friday, March 8th. If your child does get invited back for the third day of tryouts, but they are unable to attend, they will not be considered for the team.

- Monday, March 4th - day one of tryouts
- Thursday, March 7th - day two of tryouts (cuts posted online in the evening)
- Friday, March 8th - day three of tryouts (final cuts posted online in the evening)

As mentioned before, participants do need to submit a copy of their recent physical to me before the first day of tryouts. If you have already submitted one for another sport during this current school year, then you do not need to submit another one. Players will be required to wear a plain white t-shirt with their assigned tryout number written on the front and back in large black numbering. The number needs to be clearly identifiable and visible from a distance.

All participants are to bring their own soccer ball to tryouts. It is suggested that students have their names written on their equipment to avoid any issues.

Anyone without the proper equipment, (white t-shirt with black number, soccer ball, soccer cleats, shin guards, etc.) may not be allowed to participate in tryouts and may be disqualified from making the team.
